First Report Card

Second Report Card

The second report card will be emailed home by February 24, 2026. The report card will cover the period from November 10, 2025 to February 6, 2026 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark. (Report Cards can be accessed through the **Clic École**).

Third Report Card

The Third report card will be emailed home by July 6, 2026. It will cover the period from February 9, 2026 to June 23, 2026 and will count for 60% of the student's final mark.
