ABAV Priorities

- Increase students' feeling of safety
- Increase staff and student awareness of violence and bullying
- Decrease the number of incidents of violence, sexual violence and discrimination (ISM)
- Increase staff and student awareness of sexual violence, violence, and discrimination

Actions / Initiatives to Maintain (Prevention Measures)

- Implementing SEL initiatives with individual students
- Implementing student behaviour trackers for at-risk students
- Activities promoting students to learn about expected behaviours (monthly assemblies, Caught Being Kind certificates etc.) in line with core values of the school
- Carrying out activities that reinforce a sense of belonging and a positive school climate (assemblies, dances, concerts, thematic days, morning announcements by students, birthday announcements with birthday certificate and surprise, etc)
- Promoting the sensory rooms as a tool to support SEL
- Special Education Technicians (2x) 5 days/week to support Preschool, and Cycles 1-3.
- CCQ/ sexuality education curriculum
- PSD consultations
- Sensory room used for restorative practices
- Student Leadership initiatives (Grade 5 & 6)
- ECA lunch-time clubs for students (Ukelele Club, Talent Show, Game Club, etc.)
- Cycle and school-wide field trips

Actions / Initiatives to Maintain (Sexual Violence)

Actions to maintain for prevention of sexual violence:

- CCQ / Sexuality of Education Curriculum and support from PSD
- Workshops from Enfance Libre about sexual violence prevention and bodily autonomy

Actions / Initiatives to Maintain (Bullying or violence based on motives related, in particular, to skin colour and ethnic or national background)

- CCQ curriculum about cultural diversity and inclusion
- Orange Shirt Day (September)
- Black history month (February)

Actions / Initiatives to Develop

- School-wide SEL initiatives
- Training for all staff (Karl Mercuri- school climate)
- Code of Conduct explained at school assembly in September
- Standardize Behaviour Flow Chart
- Informative bulletin-board about SEL / social issues / diversity
